



Youth Programming Aggregate Results for Routt County –2010-2011

Grand Futures Prevention Coalition collected 190 post-surveys, administered at various youth presentations, throughout the 2010-2011 fiscal year. Local experts were on sight to either give the presentation, or to answer questions from the audience. While post-surveys focused on the same main topics, not all had the same group of questions. The results below show the number of respondents to each question as well as the corresponding percentages.

Presentation titles were:

Juvenile Justice Symposium at Hayden High School
 Athletic Series at Steamboat Springs High School with Guest Speaker Ryan Wood
 Athletic Series at Steamboat Springs High School with Guest Speaker Kyle Craig
 Leadership Training for the Steamboat Springs Teen Council with Todd Musselman

Demographic Information: Not all individuals chose to provide their demographic information, however, the information provided indicated that the respondents were made up of 57.0% (n=51) male and 43.0% (n=38) female. 100% of respondents indicated that they attended high school (n=190).

Presentation Feedback: When indicating their level of agreement with the statements below, respondents were given the options of; strongly agree, agree, neither agree nor disagree, disagree, and strongly disagree. Points of interest as well as full results are shown below.

- 86% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed that the format of the presentation(s) was understandable and easy to follow.
- 86% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed that the information provided by the experts was helpful.
- 82% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed that they have a better understanding of the presentation’s topic. However, of those, only 16% strongly agreed to the statement.
- Only 9% of respondents strongly agreed that the event provided the information that they expected.
- Only 75% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed to plan on sharing what they learned with friends and family.
- Overall, 22% of respondents strongly agreed with questions asked; 58% agreed; 16% neither disagreed nor agreed; 2% disagreed; 1% strongly disagreed.

Other Topics of Interest: The post-survey also asked youth which other topics they would like to see offered by Grand Futures and its partners. Results indicated that the majority of respondents were interested in Substance Abuse (38%) and Mental Health (31%). Respondents were also interested in Parent Support (16%) and Youth Development (15%).
